Pro-Cards: Up to \$1,000 in restricted purchases, limits vary by division

Division Purchases: Divisions can make purchases \$1,000 to \$10,000 with 3 informal quotes and approval by Central Purchasing

Formal Quotes: \$10,000 to \$20,000 commodities and services, posted on Economic Engine

Bids: \$20,000 and up commodities and services, advertised in the paper, posted on Economic Engine

Request for Proposals (RFP): \$25,000 and above for professional services such as attorney fees, engineering services, consultants, project managers etc.; advertised in the paper and posted on Economic Engine
