The class is the second to graduate in the program's two years under the guidance of Marilyn Clark, the minority business enterprise liaison in the Division of Central Purchasing. There were 13 graduates in the first year of the program.

Mayor Jim Gray spoke to the graduating class, noting that small businesses like those enrolled in the program fuel America's economy. "When small business owners are successful, they give back to the community in many ways. They hire new employees, they give to local charities, they become community leaders and they inspire a new generation of entrepreneurs who want to follow in their footsteps," the Mayor noted.

Several businesses from the class of 2011 found work with the LFUCG, including USA Lawns. One of the government's construction supervisors praised the company, saying that they met time constraints and the quality of their work exceeded expectations.

Several members of the 2012 class have found or are finding work with the government or program sponsors, including G&G Paving, Five D Enterprise, SAKS Art Gallery, Fayette Window Cleaning and Advance Electric Service.
