Dear Mr. Atwood:

We propose to remove thirty pieces of 1/4" plate glass in your existing wood storefront and replace it with the following insulated glass:

Five Jumbo size insulated units 1" overall with clear standard low-e tempered safety glass. Jumbos cost about twice as much and do not have any warranty.

Twenty Five various size insulated units with clear standard low-e tempered safety glass.

Note: We are reusing your existing wood stops. We are assuming none of the wood is bad. If some get broken or are rotten you will be responsible to pay for the new replacement wood and extra labor to prepare the same. No painting or staining is included in this quote if any is necessary for the new wood. We will caulk the new windows in place.

All the above including freight and installation for the sum of: Thirteen Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$13,600.00).

Alternate 1: For bronze or gray tinted units in lieu of the clear above add: \$300.00 to the price above.

Alternate 2: For Argon gas in the units add: \$275.00 to the price above.

Our price includes all necessary insurance. We did not include cleaning the glass or protection of the glass once it is installed.
