





SIGN UP FOR LEXINGTON'S STREET TREE INVENTORY

WHAT: Assist Lexington Urban Forestry staff count and identify the street trees in Lexington. Street trees are located along city medians, sidewalks, right of ways, and in tree wells downtown. Street trees provide environmental, economic, and social benefits to the community.

WHY: The inventory will give Urban Forestry staff an idea of the overall health and condition of the urban forest. It will also provide an opportunity for citizens to learn more about the trees in our community.

WHEN: May 15 - October 15. Contact Urban Forester Tim Queary to set up training for your neighborhood, church or civic group. Also a great way to earn community service hours for your fraternity or sorority! Groups will be trained in basic tree identification, data collection and how to measure a tree.

No prior tree knowledge required. Most surveys can be done in half a day.
