

The following ordinances were signed by Mayor Jim Gray, attested by Council Clerk Susan Lamb and published on May 9, 2013-1t.

Ord. No. 48-2013-An Ordinance changing the zone from a Professional Office (P-1) zone to a Planned Neighborhood Residential (R-3) zone for 4.09 net and gross acres, for property located at 1060 Cross Keys Rd. (AU Associates, Inc.; Council District 11). Passed May 2, 2013

Ord. No. 49-2013-An Ordinance amending Section 16-16.1 of the Code of Ordinances to create Schedule E setting the solid waste-landfill fee for dumpster containers (2CY) at \$12.05 per container per month. Be It Ordained By the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1 – That Section 16-16.1 of the Code of Ordinances, Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is amended to read as follows: Rates and charges for landfill-solid waste disposal are hereby established as follows: *Schedule A:* The landfill-solid waste disposal fee for roll cart containers or roll cart container equivalents shall be four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50) per container per month. *Schedule B:* The landfill-solid waste disposal fee for dumpster containers (8CY) shall be forty-eight dollars and twenty cents (\$48.20) per container per month. *Schedule C:* The landfill-solid waste disposal fee for dumpster containers (6CY) shall be thirty-six dollars and fifteen cents (\$36.15) per container per month. *Schedule D:* The landfill-solid waste disposal fee for dumpster containers (4CY) shall be twenty-four dollars and ten cents (\$24.10) per container per month. *Schedule E:* The landfill-solid waste disposal fee for dumpster containers (2CY) shall be twelve dollars and five cents (\$12.05) per container per month. Section 2 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage. Passed May 2, 2013

Ord. No. 51-2013-An Ordinance amending certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and appropriating and re-appropriating funds, Schedule No. 50. Whereas, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures: Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained By the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1 - That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed:)\$1,600,000.00 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the General Service District – General Fund to various accounts.)Re-appropriations within the General Service District – General Fund; Donation Fund; Bond Project – FY 2011 Fund; 2014 Bond Projects Fund; Enhanced 911 Fund; and the various grant funds which do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these funds. Section 2 - That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in Budget Schedule No. 50 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
