Ord. 32-2014-An Ordinance amending Section 21-5(2) of the Code of Ordinances, abolishing one (1) position of GIS Specialist, Grade 114N, and creating one (1) position of Administrative Specialist Principal, Grade 114E, both in the Div. of Enterprise Solutions, appropriating funds pursuant to Schedule No. 51, effective upon passage of Council. Passed April 10, 2014

Ord. 33-2014-An Ordinance amending Section 23-5(2) of the Code of Ordinances, abolishing one (1) position of Police Captain, Grade 318E, and creating one (1) position of Police Lieutenant, Grade 317E, both in the Div. of Police, appropriating funds pursuant to Schedule No. 50, effective upon passage of Council. Passed April 10, 2014

Ord. 34-2014-An Ordinance creating Section 1-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to provide for use of the name "Lexington" for identification or promotional purposes. Passed April 10, 2014

Ord. 35-2014-An Ordinance amending certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and appropriating and re-appropriating funds, Schedule No. 48. Whereas, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures: Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained By the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1 - That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed:) \$25,000 to the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the General Services District Fund from various accounts.) Re-appropriations within the General Services District Fund; Donations Fund; Full Urban Services District Fund; Municipal Aid Program Fund; FY 2011 Bond Projects Fund; and the various grant funds which do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these funds. Section 2 - That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in "Budget Schedule No. 48" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage. Passed April 10, 2014

Ord. 36-2014-An Ordinance amending certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to provide \$75,000 for projects at Berry Hill Park and appropriating and re-appropriating funds, Schedule No. 53. Whereas, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to provide \$75,000 for projects at Berry Hill Park: Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained By the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1 - That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to provide \$75,000 for projects at Berry Hill Park, and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed:) Re-appropriations within the General Service District – General Fund and PFC-Parks Projects Fund that do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balances of these fund. Section 2 - That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in "Budget Schedule No. 53", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage. Passed April 10, 2014
