**Res. 142-2014**-A Resolution specifying the intention of the Urban County Council to expand and extend Partial Urban Services District #3 to provide garbage and refuse collection; finding a need for this service in the area included; finding the ability of the Urban County Government to provide this service in this area, which area is defined as certain properties on the following street: 211 through 611 Arcadia Park. Be It Resolved By the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1 – That pursuant to Section 2.04 of the Charter of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, the Urban County Council hereby specifies its intention to expand Partial Urban Services District #3 to provide garbage and refuse collection. Section 2 – That the Urban County Council hereby specifies its intention to include the following properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land within Partial Urban Services District #3: District 03 Address Range Street 211-611 Arcadia Park Section 3 – That the Urban County Council has made the following findings: A. That the properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land described in Section 2 above are within areas of residential and commercial development and are urban in character. B. That as a result of this urbanization and in order to protect the public health, safety and general welfare of the residents, the Council finds that: In order to provide for the orderly removal of garbage and refuse from residences and commercial establishments on a timely basis, there is a need for garbage and refuse collection in said area. C. That the Urban County Government has the ability to provide to the properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land described in Section 2 above the urban service of garbage and refuse collection. Section 4 – That the Clerk of the Urban County Council be and hereby is directed to cause the contents of this Resolution to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Fayette County at least once a week for a period of three consecutive weeks. Section 5 – That a public hearing will be held on May 6, 2014, at 3 p.m., in the Urban County Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, Government Center, 200 E. Main St., Lexington, Ky. 40507, for the purpose of informing and receiving the views of all interested persons concerning the expansion and extension of the Urban Services specified herein. Section 6 – That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage. Passed: April 10, 2014

Be It Resolved By the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1 – That pursuant to Section 2.04 of the Charter of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, the Urban County Council hereby specifies its intention to expand and extend Partial Urban Services District #5 to provide the urban services of street lighting and garbage and refuse collection. Section 2 – That the Urban County Council hereby specifies its intention to include the following properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land within the Partial Urban Services District #5: Tax District 05 Address Range Street 107-209 Arcadia Park Section 3 – That the Urban County Council has made the following findings: A. That the properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land described in Section 2 above are within areas of residential and commercial development and are urban in character. B. That as a result of this urbanization and in order to protect the public health, safety and general welfare of the residents, the Council finds that: 1. In order to provide well lit, safe streets to deter crime and contribute to traffic safety, there is a need for street lighting in said area. 2. In order to provide for the orderly removal of garbage and refuse from residences and commercial establishments on a timely basis, there is a need for garbage and refuse collection in said area. C. That the Urban County Government has the ability to provide to the properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land described in Section 2 above the urban services of street lighting and garbage and refuse collection. Section 4 – That the Clerk of the Urban County Council be and hereby is directed to cause the contents of this Resolution to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Fayette County at least once a week for a period of three consecutive weeks. Section 5 – That a public hearing will be held on May 6, 2014 at 3 p.m., in the Urban County Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, Government Center, 200 E. Main St., Lexington, Ky. 40507, for the purpose of informing and receiving the views of all interested persons concerning
