Re-appropriations within the General Services District – General Fund; the Municipal Aid Program Fund; and various grant funds which do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these funds. Section 2 - That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in "Budget Schedule No. 18" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Ord. 132-2014-An Ordinance amending Section 22-5(2) of the Code of Ordinances extending the term of the temporary position of one (1) Administrative Specialist Principal, Grade 518E, and three (3) positions of Administrative Specialist, Grade 513N, for a term of two (2) years beginning September 23, 2014 and expiring on September 23, 2016, in the Div. of Water Quality, effective upon passage of Council.
