Ord 131-2015-An Ordinance amending certain of the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and appropriating and reappropriating funds, Schedule No 14. Whereas, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures: Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1-That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed: \$568,188.41 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the General Services District Fund to various accounts. \$7,265.30 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Full Urban Services District Fund to various accounts. \$1,897,270.26 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Municipal Aid Program Fund to various accounts. \$255,021.00 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Sanitary Sewer Revenue and Operating Fund to various accounts. \$286,213.30 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Water Quality Management Fund to various accounts. Re-appropriations within the General Services District Fund; Donations Fund; Affordable Housing and Homelessness Prevention Fund; Refunding GO Bond 2015A; Sanitary Sewer Construction Fund; and the various grant funds which do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these funds Section 2-That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in "Budget Schedule No. 14" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference Section 3-That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage. Passed November 19, 2015
