

The following Ordinances were signed by Mayor Jim Gray, attested by Council Clerk Martha Allen and published on January 28, 2016-1t.

O-3-2016-An Ordinance amending certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and appropriating and re-appropriating funds, Schedule No. 19. Whereas, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures: Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government: Section 1-That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed: Re-appropriations within the General Services District-General Fund; Donation Fund; Tenant Relocation Fund; Municipal Aid Program Fund; Sanitary Sewer Construction Fund; and the various grant funds that do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these funds Section 2-That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in "Budget Schedule No. 19" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference Section 3- That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage. Passed January 21, 2016.

O-4-2016-An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by abolishing one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Staff Assistant Sr., Grade 510N, and creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Administrative Specialist, Grade 513N, in the Div. of Water Quality, and reclassifying the incumbent, effective upon passage of Council. Passed January 21, 2016

O-5-2016-An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by abolishing one (1) Unclassified Civil Service Position of Family Support Worker Sr. Grade 514N, and creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Volunteer Coordinator, Grade 514N, in the Div. of Family Services, effective upon passage of Council. Passed January 21, 2016

O-6-2016-An Ordinance pursuant to Code of Ordinances Section 18-83, designating Wickliffe St. between Martin Luther King Blvd. and Spruce St. as a one-way street and authorizing and directing the Div. of Traffic Engineering to install proper and appropriate signs and markings in accordance with the designation. Passed January 21, 2016

O-7-2016-An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by abolishing one (1) Unclassified Civil Service Position of HANDS Nurse, Grade 514E, and creating one (1) Unclassified Civil Service Position of HANDS Nurse, Grade 514N, in the Div. of Family Services, effective upon passage of Council. Passed January 21, 2016

O-8-2016-An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by changing the pay grade for one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Director of Revenue from Grade 531E to Grade 532E, and reallocating the incumbent, in the Div. of Revenue, effective upon passage of Council. Passed January 21, 2016
