

MAYOR'S PROPOSED BUDGET

FY17



It's budget time at City Hall! Mayor Jim Gray unveiled his proposed \$345M budget to the Urban County Council in early April. Now the Council is in process of reviewing the budget and meeting with City divisions to make sure your tax-paying dollars are spent wisely.

Below are a few highlights of the proposed budget plan:

- Division of Police- funding for 20 new officers, \$600K for body cameras.
- Division of Fire & Emergency Services- \$5M for a new fire station, \$3M for vehicles.
- Division of Streets and Roads- \$10M for paving local streets and roads.
- Division of Parks and Recreation- \$3M for aquatics improvements.
- Division of Engineering- \$934K to upgrade traffic signals, \$250K for pedestrian safety projects.

Update: Gainesway Shared Use Trail Project

Construction of the Gainesway Shared Use Trail is scheduled to begin this Spring! It will connect to Gainesway Park and extend south to Armstrong Mill Road; at which point the trail will continue east to River Park Drive and west to Caulder Road. A safe facility for pedestrians and bicyclists alike, the Gainesway Trail will only add to the livability of the 8th district by providing an opportunity for increased physical activity for the community.

Spring time is a beautiful time of year in Lexington, and busy too! The school year is coming to a close, families are planting their gardens, and my colleagues and I are working on passing a budget for fiscal year 2017 (FY17).

We have a good surplus and this helps us to have a very positive budget for next year. My priorities are what I call the "3Ps": Public Safety, Parks, and Paving.

For FYI7 we are bringing our authorized strength in the police department to an all-time high of 600 officers.

We are providing more funds for park and aquatic improvements. A masterplan for the entire park system is in the works.

We are again providing a large amount of funding to address the City's road network. The Paving Subcommittee has been meeting since January to develop a 5 year plan that will guide road maintenance and repairs going forward.

These items are only a portion of what makes our City a great place to live! I remain committed to passing a sound, "3P" budget plan from which all residents will benefit.
