## **RESIDENTIAL SERIES** VOLUME 6 **VERSION 1** APRIL 13, 2017 An accessory structure is any structure not attached to the house such as: detached garages, storage sheds and detached decks, etc. Accessory structures less than 200 Division of square feet do not require a permit but, cannot be placed in an easement and **Building** generally may only be placed in rear yards. Permits are required for accessory Inspection structures greater than 200 square feet and a permit must be obtained prior to construction. Physical Location: If you are acting as the Owner/Builder, you will need to follow the steps below. Framing Plan and Cross Section indicating all framing materials gtonky.gov including size, spacing and span of materials (studs, joists, rafters, trusses, etc.). Footing detail to be included with framing plan. These documents can be uploaded in PDF format within the application on the online portal.
