Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Re-Opening

- **Do I need to wear a mask?** Participants that are not vaccinated are asked to wear a mask. We encourage anyone who would feel more comfortable wearing a mask to do so at anytime while at the Center.
- **What if someone gives me a hard time about my mask or the vaccine?** Bullying of any type is not acceptable at the Center. Everyone is expected to treat others with respect in regards to their choices about masks and the vaccine. If you feel uncomfortable at any time during your visit to the Center, please inform a staff member.
- **Can I have visitors at the Center?** Initially upon re-opening, no children or family members will be allowed to visit the Center.
- **What will happen if there is an increase in COVID-19 cases in Lexington?** If Fayette County's positivity rate increases and it becomes a red county, all in-person activities will be suspended ([KYCOVID19.ky.gov](https://www.ky.gov/covid19)).
- **Do I need to social distance while at the Center?** Social distancing is encouraged and will be practiced during in-person fitness classes and activities.
- **What happens if I test positive for COVID-19?** If you test positive for COVID-19, please let Senior Center staff know as soon as possible.
- **Will lunch be served at the Center?** At this time lunch will not be served in the dining room. Lunch is offered on a drive thru basis Tuesday—Thursday. You may walk up to the table to pick up your lunch but there will not be space inside for you to eat. The back patio and other outdoor spaces are open.
- **Has parking changed?** On Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, please do not park past the orange cones to avoid the lunch line.
