An accessory structure is any structure not attached to the house such as: detached garages, storage sheds, and detached decks etc. Accessory structures less than 200 square feet do not require a permit but, cannot be placed in an easement and generally may only be placed in rear yards. Permits are required for accessory structures greater than 200 square feet and a permit must be obtained prior to construction.

If you are acting as the Owner/Builder, you will need to follow the steps below. If you are hiring a Registered Contractor, the Contractor will make the application on behalf of the property owner.

To apply online, you will need to first register for an account through our online portal at: <https://lexingtonky.gov/permits> Select "New Users: Register for an account" and answer the questions. If you need help registering for your account, please call: 859-258-3770.

To apply: Select Building Inspection, agree to disclaimer, select Residential Accessory Structure

2. Information Required to Review a Residential Acc. Structure Permit:

- a. **Site Plan** which includes dimensions of lot, easements, dimensions of existing house and proposed acc. structure, and the distances from the structure to property lines. (This information can typically be found on a recorded plat from your County Clerk's office or a Mortgage deed/survey)
- b. **Floor Plan** showing the existing structure and the proposed acc. structure with the labeling of all rooms and/or spaces for their intended use.
- c. **Framing Plan and Wall Section** indicating all framing materials including size, spacing and span of materials (studs, joists, rafters, trusses, etc.). Footing detail to be included with framing plan.
- d. **Elevations** showing required design features (if applicable), location of doors and windows and height of structure.

- e. **Homeowner Acknowledgment Responsibility** Property Owner must fill out form located at:

If you are performing the work on your own property you will need to select the "Owner/Builder Acknowledgment" check box within the online application requirements. This is located on "Step 3" of the online Residential Addition Application. Additionally, property owner must complete affidavit located at: <https://www.lexingtonky.gov/sites/default/files/2018-11/CONTRACTOR%20REGISTRATION%20AFFIDAVIT.pdf>

*There may be additional requirements and/or Division approvals for properties located within an H-1 (Historic Overlay) or ND-1 Overlay. If you are unsure if your property is located in these Overlay Zones, please call us at 859-258-3770.
