Classes begin the week of September 19 and are available for both fall and spring sessions. Registration opens August 24 at noon. Lexington Parks & Recreation will follow all state and local Covid-19 recommendations and mandates.

Pottery

Beginning/Intermediate Hand Building

Tuesdays, 6-8:30 p.m. | ages 16 & up | \$150 per session

Session 1: September 20 - November 29 (229000-PB)

Session 2: February 7 - April 18 (429000-PB)

These classes teach the fundamentals of working with clay through hand building techniques. Intermediate students will further their skills with advance techniques and personalized instruction. Students will learn to hand build items including, but not limited to, pinch pots, bowls, mugs and boxes. Wheel throwing will be introduced towards the end of the class for interested students. Glazing and surface decoration are also taught. All materials provided.

Make it with "Mud" Youth Pottery

Saturdays, 10 a.m.-11:30 a.m. | ages 7-12 | \$75 per session

Session 1: October 15 - November 19 (229000-PY)

Session 2: February 11 - March 18 (429000-02)

Students will be introduced to basic building techniques through pinch pots, slab construction, and coiling. As skills develop, students will transition into more advanced forming and decoration techniques.

Beginning/Intermediate Pottery

Tuesdays, 10 a.m.-12:30 p.m. | ages 16 & up | \$150 per session

Session 1: September 20 - November 29 (229000-02)

Session 2: February 7 - April 18 (429000-02)

A daytime pottery class for all levels. This class will have both beginning instruction and guidance for more experienced students looking to improve their skills. Beginners will learn the basics of hand building, including pinch pots, coil construction and slab building. Instruction on the wheel will also be available once beginners become familiar with the basic properties of construction with clay.

Intermediate Pottery

Refine your technique and achieve new goals. This class will review the basics, then incorporate advanced work such as making lidded vessels and pulled handles, and assembling separate components. All materials including clay and glazes are provided.

Open Studio is for the hobby potter who has the skills to work independently. Participants register for Wednesday or Saturday option and may use the studio during the other class times to work, as needed. Students registered for a class get first priority on the wheels during their class times. Firing will be done by Artworks staff. Fees include use of equipment and clay.

All tools and materials are provided.

Kiddie Kapers Dance Program

Kiddie Kapers dance classes are for youth ranging in age from 2-15. All of our classes are organized by age and experience as a guide for ability levels. Classes are offered at two locations, Artworks and the Tates Creek Recreation Center, Monday-Saturday. Kiddie Kapers classes meet once per week, on the same day and time slot for 10 weeks prior to winter break and 12 weeks following winter break. Classes culminate in the fall with a holiday show and in the spring with a recital at the Lexington Opera House.

The fee for one, 22-week class is \$200 (recital costume included.) Partial scholarships are available. Visit our website at lexingtonky.gov/kiddiekapers to view the class schedule.

The following classes are offered:

- Tiny Dancers, Preschool, Beginning, Intermediate and Advanced Dance classes are a mixture of tap, jazz and ballet.
- Jazz/Hip Hop Dance classes consist of an upbeat fusion of dance including hip hop and dance team music and movements.
- Ballet includes the basics of ballet dance with barre work, floor and dance combinations.
- Acro is a style of dance that combines jazz and hip hop dance techniques with acrobatic elements.

Bluegrass Céilí Academy - Irish Dance

Irish céilí (pronounced kay-lee) dancing is the native group dancing of Ireland and is danced to traditional Irish music such as reels and jigs. Learn generations-old dances handed down through the years in addition to original choreography.
