 - e. Has posted, in a conspicuous location in the short-term rental, the following:
 - i. the name, email address, and telephone number of the Licensee or operator of the short-term rental, if different from the Licensee;
 - ii. the name, email address, and telephone number of the registered emergency contact for the short-term rental referenced in the Licensee's application for a special fees license;
 - iii. the emergency and non-emergency telephone numbers for police, fire, and emergency medical service providers;
 - iv. trash and recycling pickup information;
 - v. a clearly marked emergency evacuation plan for the premises showing exit routes, exits, and fire extinguisher locations;
 - vi. the maximum number of occupants permitted in the short-term rental;
 - vii. a copy of the conditional use permit, if applicable; and
 - viii. the website address of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government where the guest may review the locally-required duties of a Licensee and file a complaint;
 - f. No outdoor signage identifying the dwelling unit as a short-term rental.

I hereby affirm that each Short-Term Rental for which I am seeking a License complies with Section 13-76 through 13-82 of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Code of Ordinances, as well as all applicable building codes, fire codes, and all applicable state, federal, and local laws or regulations, and I hereby further acknowledge and understand that each Short-Term Rental for which I am seeking a License is required to continue to comply with paragraph 2 of this affidavit and Section 13-76 through 13-82 of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Code of Ordinances, as well as all

applicable building codes, fire codes, and all applicable state, federal, and local laws or regulations, for as long as the property is licensed.
