An audit of the agency LPR system, FLOCK, was conducted on Tuesday October 25th, 2023 in accordance with General Order 2201-01, License Plate Readers.

As of September 30, 2023, 100 LPR cameras are being managed by the Lexington Police Department. During the last quarter, Flock completed maintenance on cameras to ensure they remain operational.

A review of the monthly usage produced the below data:

July 2023

195 Users conducted a Search in the System
5553 Total searches were conducted and all listed a reason for the search
769 unique incidents or cases searched

August 2023

194 Users conducted a search in the system
5384 Total searches were conducted and all listed a reason for the search
809 unique incidents or cases searched

September 2023

187 Users conducted a search in the system
3933 Total searches were conducted and all listed a reason for the search
758 unique incidents or cases searched

A review of the search reasons showed all searches had a case number or descriptive reason listed. All Officers during In-Service training this year received a refresher training in regards to the Flock policy and utilizing Flock and how to correctly document their searches.
