Compassionate Caravan Operates as needed	Services Offered: Transportation to emergency shelter, cooling station, provides blankets, food, water and other materials. Operates as needed for cold extreme weather, for hot extreme weather operates Saturday and Sunday. Operated by Catholic Action Center.
